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Statement of Intent:

Christian Home School comprises a series of booklets, which progressively provide Scriptural knowledge and background to promote spiritual growth for all ages, particularly equipping and enabling parents, grandparents, and teachers to pass on to those, who are entrusted to them, the essences of life: Faith, confidence, and a connection with God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, by helping participating students to hear and appreciate the voice of our caring Creator, and the promise of our loving Savior.

Read, meditate on, and commit to heart:

Over the centuries various, conflicting, doctrines and practices developed in the Christian community, all claiming to be based on the "Bible," "The Word of God," "The Holy Scriptures." This occurred primarily because of personal reasons, incorrect interpretations and misapplications of "The Holy Scriptures," possibly even the unavailability of historically correct texts.

To avoid the above dilemma of misrepresentation, the author of this Christian Home School series selected approximately fifteen harmonious "Bible" passages for each booklet and its theme. Thus, with absolutely NO subjective interpretation, the author lets the "Word of God" speak for itself, that the reader may understand clearly and un-prejudicially just what the Word of the Lord conveys — and what God wants the reader to appreciate.

In the interest of objectivity, the author consistently uses the translation of the New King James Version, which is based on the text of the 1611 King James Bible, as revised on the basis of best available historical Greek/Hebrew texts and presented in a colloquially up to date language. If the author deviated from this text, because of the dictates by Greek/Hebrew grammar, such deviations are identified by an asterisk*.

The objective of the author is to present the truth, as revealed by God in recorded and divine revelation, and to do so in a very simple, yet in a very challenging manner: Simple, that a young child can commit it to memory, and challenging, that meditating adults can learn it by heart.

Specific Recommendations:

- 1. As needed, download, print, distribute and supervise the study of all 40 numbered CHS booklets. (pdf booklet format)
- 2. Maintain records for each participant and each booklet.
- 3. Use the index as CHS Progress Record Sheet. (See next page.)
- 4. Reward all completed readings and memory work, by at least changing the empty circle into a happy face. Example from Booklet 1:

General Recommendations:

- 1. The participant embarks on a comprehensive ongoing study of 39 Biblical topics and 550 Bible quotations, which require commitment.
- 2. Acknowledge and promote good healthy habits and relationships, encouraging persistence and the completion of the entire series.
- 3. The Biblical texts of each booklet may serve as the basis for topical sermons, and private or group Bible studies.
- 4. Parents and presenters may assign, adjust, and check memory work to suit the individual needs and abilities of participants and children.
- 5. Spend time, and encourage each participant and child by talking about the suggested readings, and the memory work.
- 6. Train older children and siblings to assume the role of presenter.
- 7. After checking memory work, read in unison at least one simple prayer.
- 8. Memory work is re-affirmed by periodic review of completed booklets.

 Scriptures. Recommended initial readings: The Gospel of John, the
 Gospel of Matthew, 1 Peter, Philippians, Psalms, and others.
