Miracles Of Jesus.

[Changing water into wine]

Now there were set there six water pots of stone, ... containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece. Jesus said to them, "Fill the water pots with water." And they filled them up to the brim. And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast."... When the master of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine ...

This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory; and His disciples believed in Him.

*Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying,
"I am willing; be cleansed."*

Immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

(2) Matthew 8: 3



*When Jesus had come into Peter's house,
He saw his wife's mother lying sick with a fever.*

He touched her hand; the fever left her.

And she arose and served them.

(3) Matthew 8: 14, 15



He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet:

He Himself took our infirmities; and bore our sicknesses.

(4) Matthew 8:16, 17



A great tempest arose on the sea, so that the boat was covered with the waves. But He was asleep. Then His disciples came to Him and awoke Him, "Lord, save us! We are perishing!"

But He said to them,

"Why are you fearful, O you of little faith?"

He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea.

And there was a great calm. So the men marveled, saying, "Who can this be, that even the winds and the sea obey Him?"

(5) Matthew 8: 24-27



They brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed.

When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic,

"Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you."

Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise and walk'?

But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins" — then He said to the paralytic,

"Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house."

(6) Matthew 9: 2-6



Two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying,

"Son of David, have mercy on us!"

And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And Jesus said to them,

"Do you believe that I am able to do this?"

They said to Him, "Yes, Lord."

Then He touched their eyes, saying,

"According to your faith let it be to you."

And their eyes were opened.

(7) Matthew 9: 27-29



And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke.

***The multitudes marveled, saying,
“It was never seen like this in Israel!”***

(8) Matthew 9: 32, 33



So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

***And Jesus took the loaves, and when He had given thanks
He distributed them to the disciples, and the disciples to those
sitting down; and likewise of the fish, as much as they wanted.***

***So when they were filled, He said to His disciples,
“Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing is lost.”***

(9) John 6: 10-12



Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice,

“Lazarus, come forth!”

And he who had died came out.

***Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples,
