Pray without ceasing.

(1) 1 Thessalonians 5: 17



***Call upon Me in the day of trouble;
I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me.***

(2) Psalm 50:15



Seek the LORD while He may be found.

Call upon Him while He is near.

(3) Isaiah 55: 6



***Continue earnestly in prayer,
being vigilant in it with thanksgiving.***

(4) Colossians 4: 2



***Be anxious for nothing,
but in everything by prayer and supplication,
with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.***

(5) Philippians 4: 6



***Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find.
Knock, and it will be opened to you.***

(6) Luke 11; 9



When you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door. Pray to your Father who is in the secret place. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.
