Specific Christian Responsibilities.

Children:

***Honor your father and your mother, so that
you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.***

(1) Exodus 20: 12



Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

(2) Ephesians 6: 1



***Listen, my son, to your father's instruction
and do not forsake your mother's teaching.***

(3) Proverbs 1: 8



Fathers:

***Fathers, do not exasperate your children.
Instead, bring them up in the training
and instruction of the Lord.***

Husbands:

***Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church
and gave Himself for her.***

***Let each one of you in particular

Wives:

***Wives, submit to your own husbands,
as to the Lord.***
