(2) *Genesis 12: 3.* - The Promise by way of Abraham.

(3) *Genesis 26: 4.* - The Promise by way of Isaac.



***“A Star shall come out of Jacob.  
A Scepter shall rise out of Israel.”***

(4) *Numbers 24: 17.* - A Promise by way of Israel.



***I will set up your seed after you,  
who will come from your body  
and I will establish his kingdom.***

(5) *2 Samuel 7: 12.* - The Promise by way of King David.



***Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son,  
and shall call His name Immanuel.***

(6) *Isaiah 7: 14*



***For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given.  
And the government will be upon His shoulder.  
And His name will be called  
Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God,  
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.***

*(7) Isaiah 9: 6*



***But you, Bethlehem Ephrata,  
though you are little among the thousands of Judah,  
yet out of you shall come forth to Me  
the One to be Ruler in Israel.***

*(8) Micah 5:1*



***Behold, your King is coming to you.  
He is just and having salvation,  
lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey.***

*(9) Zechariah 9. 9*



***“You will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son,  
and shall call His name JESUS.***

*He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and  
the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David.*

*He will reign over the house of Jacob forever,  
and of His kingdom there will be no end.”*

*(10) Luke 1: 31-33. - The promise by way of Mary.*



***She brought forth her firstborn Son,  
and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths,  
and laid Him in a manger,  
because there was no room for them in the inn.***

*(11) Luke 2: 7*



*He is despised and rejected by men,  
a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief.  
And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him.  
He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.*

***Surely He has borne our griefs***

***And carried our sorrows.***

*Yet we esteemed Him stricken,  
Smitten by God, and afflicted.*

***He was wounded for our transgressions.***

***He was bruised for our iniquities.***

***The chastisement for our peace was upon Him,  
and by His stripes we are healed.***

*(12) Isaiah 53: 3-5*



***The Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of men.***

***They will kill Him; and after He is killed,***

***He will rise the third day.***

*(13) Mark 9: 31. - The Prediction of His Death and Resurrection.*



***You will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand  
of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven.***

*(14) Matthew 26: 64. - The Prediction of His Ascension.*



***I, Jesus, ... I am the Root and the Offspring of David,  
the Bright and Morning Star ... Surely I am coming quickly.***
