Pilate took Jesus and scourged Him.
The soldiers twisted a crown of thorns and put it on His head.

John 19: 1, 2

[Jesus], bearing His cross, went out to a place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha, where they crucified Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center. Now Pilate wrote a title and put it on the cross. And the writing was: [INRI]

JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS.

John 19: 17-19

Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, said, ... "It is finished!" and bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

INDEX

nor will you allow your Holy One to see corruption.

When Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and laid it in his new tomb, which he had hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb.

The Coming Again Of Christ.

INDEX

I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself that where I am, there you may be also.

John 14: 3

"Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

Acts 1: 11

He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age, but also in that which is to come.

Ephesians 1: 20, 21

He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.
